How much can I expect to pay? The amount you pay will depend on your order, see menu fliers or visit our web site for more information.

Volunteer service is anything you or members of your family do to help someone else. For example volunteer at a church, babysitting, mowing a neighbors yard, Scouting, 4-H, etc. Participants have an entire month to fulfill the volunteer hours that can be broken into small periods of time. Sign up and payment for your order are required during specific dates each month at the distribution site where you choose to participate, or you can sign up at www.prairielandfood.com.
